**God's law is written in our hearts
We need *only to carry it out.***

"Moses said to the people: 'If only you would heed the voice of the Lord, your God, and keep His commandments and statutes that are written in the book of the law, when you return to the Lord your God with all your hearts and with all your soul...' 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart...being...strength...and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.' He replied to him, 'You have answered rightly, do this and you will live.' 'And who is my neighbor?'"

Perhaps the best known parable of Jesus, using the law of the first testament, tells us how we remain 'connected' a very popular expression. Whether we are using an ipad, cell phone or computer, being connected is essential.

I can ask myself if I really work at being connected - with my heart, my being, my strength and soul - to my God. Do I have the courage to approach the Lord as did the scholar of the law?

I pray, I keep the Commandments; the beatitudes are a guiding force in my life as I address the needs of my neighbor. How wonderful to live so well. But am I willing to take the extra step as portrayed in the person who treated the downtrodden one with mercy? Pope Francis has told us that when we have experienced mercy, it is then that we can exhibit mercy. We are all called to be the Good Samaritan.
