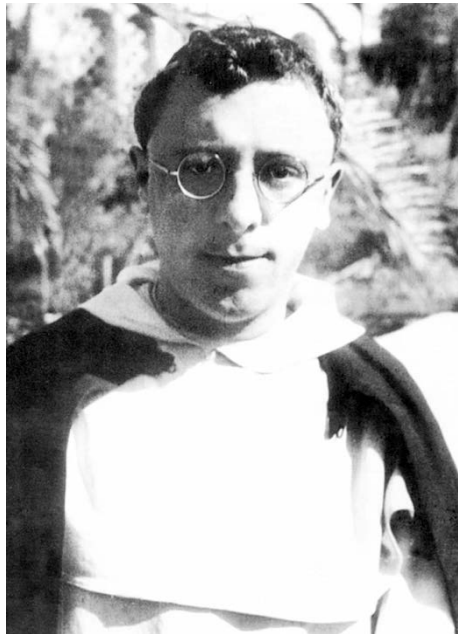

Saint of the Week

April 2 | *Blessed Giuseppe Girotti, OP*

Giuseppe Girotti was born on July 19, 1905 in northern Italy. He entered the Dominican seminary when he was 13 years old and was ordained in 1930. He was soon recognized as a brilliant scholar and sent to Rome and Jerusalem to study for advanced degrees in Scripture and theology. Finally, he returned to Italy to teach in the Dominican Theological Seminary of Turin.



Stemming from his scriptural studies, Fr. Giuseppe acquired a great love for the Jewish people. He viewed them as his elder brothers in the faith. When the Nazis occupied Italy and started their campaign against the Jews, Fr. Giuseppe went to great lengths to support them. He found safe shelters and a security network for them, transporting them out of harm's way, even to issuing false baptismal certificates. He was betrayed by someone posing to need his help, and was arrested on August 29, 1944, eventually being sent to Dachau. Thousands of other priests and clergy were imprisoned there along with him in a bunker designed to house 180.

Within the filthy, overcrowded conditions of the concentration camp, Fr. Giuseppe radiated joy and deep faith. Due to the toxic atmosphere he fell ill. On Easter Sunday, April 1, 1945 he was given a lethal injection of gasoline. In 1995 he was honored with the Jewish title of "Righteous Among the Nations" and in 2014 Fr. Giuseppe Girotti was beatified by Pope Francis.

Blessed Giuseppe Girotti, intercede for us, that we may remain faithful to the gospel no matter what price we may be called to pay.
